Location

KICH is easily accessible from Kansai International Airport (KIX) via Kyoto Station using the JR Express Haruka train and subway. KIX is serviced by more than 50 airlines with direct flights being available from all parts of the world.

Conference attendees will have the opportunity to see beautiful and exotic "Yamaboko" floats used in this festival.
